Healthy for Life Community Nutrition Grant - The American Heart Association and Aramark launched Healthy for Life®, an innovative health impact initiative, in 2015. The commitment: work together to leverage our combined reach and resources to help millions lead healthier lives. The Healthy for Life community nutrition program goals, are intended to:

- Increase skills and confidence in preparing and cooking healthy food.

- Increase knowledge of how to connect food choices with daily goals.

Criteria: The American Heart Association requires the organization applying for the grant be able to meet the following eligibility criteria.

Panelist duties include reviewing proposals; drafting and submitting individual scores and written reviews; attending and participating in a panel meeting. During the panel meeting panelists discuss and reach a group consensus on proposal rankings. Panels may be conducted via teleconference or at in-person meeting spaces.
