

Call for Proposals for presentations for the 2023-2024 NEAFCS Leadership Experience Cohort program. The cohort program will be conducted via zoom and each of the presentations will be 40 minutes long. Presentations utilizing interactive, engaging activities are highly encouraged. Available times, dates, and topics are listed along with brief keywords to help you understand what the committee is looking for in each of the sessions.

You may submit one form for each slot you wish to submit a proposal for. Below are the available dates/times and topics we are looking for. You may only select ONE slot per submission so if you wish to submit more than one proposal, please submit a new form for each one.

- June 9, 2023: 9-11:30 am (PST) "Taking Care of Yourself First" could include topics such as Self-Care, Self-Compassion, and Mindfulness.
- August 11, 2023: 9-11:30 am (PST) "Diversity/Equity/Inclusion " could also include topics such as Networking, Partnerships, and Emotional Intelligence.
- October 13, 2023: 9-11:30 am (PST) "Community Development" could include topics such as Identifying Needs, Identifying Community Assets, Strategic Planning, Consensus or Coalition Building, and Impacts/ Outcomes.
- December 8, 2023: 9-11:30 am (PST) "Growth mindset" could include: Developing Your Image, Your Brand, Self-Promotion, Investing in Yourself, Mentoring, Growing Competencies, and/or Followership.
- February 9, 2024: 9-11:30 am (PST) "The Extension Professional" could include topics such as Professional Development, Committee work, Ethics, Research, and Scholarly Work.

Please note, if chosen to present, the following will be expected of you:

- You must be available to present live on the day and time of the slot you are submitting for.
- You will also be asked to provide a headshot and short bio as well as handouts, assignments, and PowerPoint if applicable prior to the event.

Details will be provided to you in full upon acceptance. The <u>deadline to submit a proposal is May 1,</u> <u>2023</u>. All applicants will be notified of whether they were selected or not.
