HISTORY  
NC ASSOCIATION OF EXTENSION HOME ECONOMIST

In 1926 a steering committee was selected to make plans for an organization of Home Demonstration Agents. Mrs. Maud McInnis, Wake County acted as chairman with Miss Daisy Caldwell, Franklin County, as secretary and Mrs. Octavia Evans, Durham County, as treasurer.

December 1927, Mrs. McInnis presided at the meeting for the agents and officers were elected as follows: Mrs. Rosaline Redfearn, president; Miss Anna Rowe, vice-president; Mrs. Maud McInnis, secretary and Miss Minnie Lee Garrison, treasurer. The first thought of the organization was one of service. The first and only item of business of this meeting was the establishment of the Jane S. McKimmon loan fund. Each agent contributed \$3.00 to this fund. In 1929, these funds were turned over to the Federation of Home Demonstration Clubs. In 1930 it was decided to give a love offering to the fund each year and this has never been less than \$50.00 per year. In 1940 the association held three meetings which was very unusual.

Representatives were sent to the National Organization in June of 1934. The National Association was organized June 21, 1933. Lois Ranwater - 1946 and Eugenia Van Landingham - 1954-55 were presidents of the National Association from North Carolina. No meetings were held in 1942-43 because of the war.

In 1949 the State Home Agents Association organized. They were very active and accomplished much with the Negro Extension Agents.

The Distinguished Service Award was started and NC agents first received this in 1946. NC had a Grace Frysinger Fellowship winner in 1951.

In 1964 the Negro State Home Agents Association merged with the Home Demonstration Agents Association. In 1965 we underwent a name change to NC Association of Extension Home Economists.

Approximately 135-140 agents have received Distinguished Service Awards in NC. Superior Service Awards were presented in 1965 to Mary Cornwell, Haywood County and in 1981 to Jane Davidson, Forsyth County. As a state organization we are more active and involved each year on local, state and national levels. We are history in the making!
