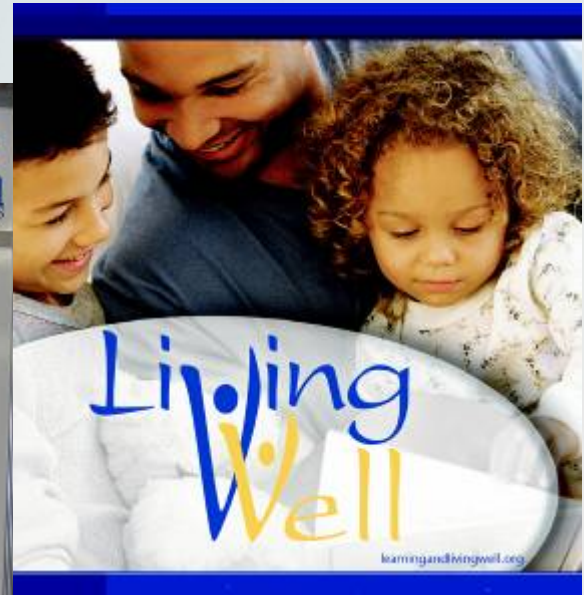


NEAFCS Millennium Challenge Legislative Task Force of the Public Affairs Committee
